DISCUSSION GUIDE

GOSPEL OF JOHN

John 4:1-42

CONTEXT

Set against the backdrop of the encounter between Jesus and Nicodemus, we now see another encounter between Jesus and a Samaritan woman. Culturally speaking, in that day, Samaritan and Jews despised one another. Moreover, Samaritan women were “considered in rabbinic tradition to be the lowest of the low” (Klink, 237). However, these cultural distinctions do not seem to bother Jesus. He’s more interested in a “food” that his disciples don’t know about.

STRUCTURE OF THE TEXT

- 4:1-6 Jesus travels through Samaria
- 4:7-26 An Encounter with Jesus at Jacob’s Well
- 4:27-38 Jesus’s “Food”
- 4:39-42 “The Savior of the World”

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Have you ever wondered if Jesus is for you? What might it be like to believe that you need saving, but to be unsure if you can be saved?
2. What unique details does the narrative give us about the identity of Jesus?
3. What misunderstandings about Jesus or about God are in the story?
4. What surprising or culturally unexpected things does Jesus say or do in this story?
5. What promises or proclamations does Jesus make in this story?
6. What declarations are made about Jesus in the story?
7. Compare the responses to Jesus of the disciples and the Samaritan woman. After talking with Jesus, what is she interested in doing? What are the disciples concerned about?
8. In what ways are you more interested in material matters than spiritual ones?
9. Consider the effect of the Samaritan woman’s testimony on the town. How does this convict you? Encourage you?
10. After spending time with Jesus for a couple days, the townspeople declare that Jesus is “the Savior of the world.” Why is this such good news for Samaritans and for the rest of us?
