## DISCUSSION GUIDE

---

### GOSPEL OF JOHN

John 6:59-71

## CONTEXT

---

After explaining to the crowd that he is the bread of life who has come down from heaven, Jesus turns to a group of his disciples who are also now confused and grumbling about what he said. Instead of softening his message, Jesus raises the stakes with an even more difficult saying about himself and his mission that causes many to turn away.

59-63 Grumbling disciples and an even harder saying

64-65 Those who don't believe

66-71 Simon Peter's Response

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

---

1. Looking back to the previous section (John 6:22-58), what was the hard saying that made the crowd grumble? What do you think made it such a hard saying?
2. How do people in your life tend to respond to the difficult things Jesus says or other hard sayings in the Bible?
3. How does Jesus respond to the grumbling of his disciples?
4. What does Jesus say about the source of life? What ultimately determines who will believe, have life, and come to Jesus?
5. Verse 66 tells us that many of Jesus's disciples turned back and no longer walked with him. How can we respond to those who walk away from Jesus?
6. What are you tempted to turn to when following Jesus is difficult?
7. How can Peter's response (vv. 68-69) encourage us when following Jesus is hard?
8. What does this story teach us about Jesus? How does it encourage us to respond to him?
