


# *Gospel of John*

## DISCUSSION GUIDE

---

### GOSPEL OF JOHN

John 4:43-54

### CONTEXT

---

Having been in Samaria, where he was "believed because of his word" (4:41) and known as "the Savior of the world" (4:42), Jesus resumes his journey to Galilee. But the "welcome" he receives in his "hometown" (i.e. homeland) stands in direct contrast to the one he received in Samaria. In this story, we are invited to examine the basis of our faith in Jesus and in what ways our faith need to progress.

### STRUCTURE OF THE TEXT

---

- 4:43-45 Galileans "welcomed" Jesus
- 4:46-50 Another sign in Cana
- 4:51-54 Conclusion

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

---

1. What does the story reveal about the kind of faith the Galileans had in Jesus?
2. Consider Jesus's initial response to the official's request (v48). How would you put it in your own words?
3. In what life situations or seasons, are you tempted to have a self-interested, sign-dependent faith in Jesus?
4. What does Jesus's response to the official's second plea reveal about the heart of Jesus (vv49-50)?
5. It seems that the official's faith progresses throughout the story; by the end "he himself believed, and all his household" (v53). In what ways, does your own faith in Jesus need to progress or go deeper?
6. This story reiterates the main purpose of the Gospel (John 20:30-31) and invites us to take Jesus at his word. What are areas in your life where it is difficult to take Jesus at his word?
7. What are the reasons Jesus gives us to take him at his word?
8. How does this lead you to give thanks and praise him?
