DISCUSSION GUIDE

GOSPEL OF JOHN

John 6:22-58

CONTEXT

After feeding thousands and catching up to his disciples on the rough seas in the middle of the night, both in miraculous fashion, Jesus and company had arrived in Capernaum. In the morning, when the well-fed crowds realized Jesus was not there, they went searching for him. But when they find him, instead of receiving more food, they are confronted with their true need and offered something better than bread.

STRUCTURE OF THE TEXT

6:22-24 The crowds seek Jesus

6:25-40 "I am the bread of life"

6:41-58 Feasting on Jesus

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What does Jesus say about the reason the crowds were seeking him?
2. In what ways can you identify with the seeking crowds? The grumbling and disputing religious leaders?
3. What is "the food that perishes" that you are tempted to "work for"?
4. What does Jesus say about "the food that endures to eternal life"?
5. What does Jesus say about how we feast on "the bread of life"?
6. What promises does Jesus make to those who feast on "the bread of life"?
7. How does this story point us to the work of Jesus on the Cross?
8. How does this story lead you to repent, give thanks, and praise God?
